Understanding with the BMX Group

At the May APB meeting, a local BMX Group presented their concept for using part of Lakeside Park West for a BMX track and supporting improvements (please refer to the attached map for details). Following feedback received at the May meeting, City staff conducted a review of other potential locations for a BMX facility within City parks. However, no other suitable sites were identified.

For them to operate as a USA BMX Group, they need a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City for the use of City parklands. At the June APB meeting, an Action Item is listed for "Recommending that the City Negotiate a Memorandum of Understanding with the BMX Group." Following the APB's recommendation, the City Council will then review the BMX Group's proposal and the APB's recommendation while considering a similar Action Item.

Lastly, I wanted to note that the former BMX site off N. Hickory Street is not available for the BMX Group's use. The City plans to construct a new stormwater pond on that property to meet Department of Natural Resources (DNR) requirements.
