Re: Possible Bike Projects in Lakeside Park West

Two separate bicycle groups have approached the City in their efforts to create new biking opportunities in Fond du Lac. One group involves mountain biking for youth in grades 6 through 12 and the other is a BMX group. I will note upfront that the former BMX site off N. Hickory Street is the proposed site of a new stormwater pond the City needs to construct in order to meet DNR requirements. Therefore, that property is not available to either group.

City staff have met with each group both separately and together in one meeting. The goals and facilities needed have some similarities but are mostly different so two separate locations are being reviewed, both in Lakeside Park West. I will present these locations during the meeting for your review and an open discussion.
