Design Review: The Downtown Architectural Review Board must determine that new

exterior façade alteration/ paint and sign is compatible with the spirit and intent of the Downtown Design Overlay District regulations and

the Downtown Fond du Lac Partnership Design Guidelines.

50 N Portland Street is located on Portland Street between East Division Street and East Merrill Avenue. It was the former location of the Aging & Disability Resource Center.

The current request before DARB is painting exterior trim pieces on the east and south façade to match the existing doors (dark bronze in color). The garage would be painted the same color. A new sign would be installed in the location of the existing sign.

The proposed paint color is Sherwin Williams Amory 9600. A color chip will be available at the meeting.

The proposed sign is approximately 17 sq ft in size and complies with a variance previously granted to the property.

Findings

The Downtown Design Overlay District is intended to:

- Preserve and restore unique and historic buildings;
- Ensure the coordinated design of new buildings and changes to existing buildings;
- Minimize adverse impacts on adjacent properties from buildings that may detract from the character and appearance of the district;
- Aid in improving the overall economic viability of the district.

720-42 D. (5) (a) Color and material elements apply to a building exterior that is generally visible to a public street and/or alley.

- (a) Building color should be nonreflective and relate to existing neighborhood patterns. Highintensity, fluorescent, day glow and/or neon and metallic colors are discouraged; where such colors constitute a component of a standardized corporate theme or identity, muted versions colors should be used.
- **(b)** Primary exterior building materials should be similar and/or complementary to existing structures within the immediate area and the downtown area as a whole. Building materials should consider the facades of the structure and an adjoining structure to provide a suitable transition between facades. Where a side and/or rear elevation is not exposed to view from a public street, a combination of primary and secondary materials may be used.
 - [1] Acceptable materials include glass, brick, ceramic tile, terra cotta, cultured stone, cut stone, carved stone, stucco, EIFS, wood, and decorative concrete block. Stone or brick facing shall be of relatively even coloration and consistent size. The use of nondecorative exposed concrete block, pre-engineered metal building systems, and sheet metal is discouraged. The use of plywood or oriented strand board (OSB) or similar materials is prohibited. Metal roofs, decorative metal and metal accent components may be considered. Other building materials may be considered when appropriate to a property and the downtown as a whole.

720-83 (C) Sign design. Sign shape, color, materials and illumination shall be complementary to the character and architecture of the building for which it is affixed. Signage shall reflect, to the extent practical and appropriate, the Downtown Fond du Lac Partnership Design Guidelines, as may be amended from time to time.

DARB Action

The Downtown Architectural Review Board must determine that the proposed façade alterations for paint and replacement ground sign are compatible with the spirit and intent of the Downtown Design Overlay District regulations and the Downtown Fond du Lac Partnership Design Guidelines to enhance downtown properties.





Design Review: The Downtown Architectural Review Board must determine that new

exterior façade alteration/ paint and sign is compatible with the spirit and intent of the Downtown Design Overlay District regulations and

the Downtown Fond du Lac Partnership Design Guidelines.

258 N Main Street is located on the west side of North Main Street between Follett Street and Arndt Street. It is located within the North Main Street Corridor Long Term Vision Plan area and is eligible for the new façade grant for properties within the corridor.

The applicant is seeking to paint the building. Re-stain the front log façade; update the sign face of the existing ground sign; updating the landscaping and seal coating the parking lot. The proposed stain color is included in the materials. A paint color/sample will be provided at the meeting.

Findings

The North Main Street Corridor Design Guidelines is intended to create memorable and desirable buildings and spaces within the N. Main Street corridor. The objective is to create a unique corridor that residents will love and continue to invest in for many decades. Nonresidential and multifamily developments are encouraged to meet these guidelines.

1. Architecture & Design

D. Street-facing facades should use durable and high- quality building materials. All sides of the building should include materials and design characteristics consistent with the front facade. Use of lesser quality materials for the sides and rear facades should be minimized. Vulnerable materials, such as EIFS, should not be used at the base of the building (minimum of 3 feet).

F. All buildings should have clearly-defined and welcoming entrances. Canopies, awnings, covered porches, and/or gable roof projections should be provided along facades that give access to the building to accentuate entrances and give shelter to visitors.

4. Signage & Lighting

- A. Appropriately-scaled signage is critical and should complement the building and site. Wall, projecting, and ground signs should be integrated within the overall building design in color, style and articulation.
- B. Where freestanding ground signs are proposed, the use of monument signs is preferred over pole or post mounted signs. Shrubs and/or perennial planting beds should be planted around freestanding signs.

DARB Action

The Downtown Architectural Review Board must determine that the proposed façade alterations for paint and face change for the ground sign are compatible with the spirit and intent of the Design Guidelines for the North Main Street Corridor Long Term Vision Plan.






