Re:	Process for Budget Approval and Timeline

Budget Process

- The budget process is governed by Section 65.90, *Wis. Stats*. It requires a Public Hearing on the 2022 proposed budget.
- During the Hearing, 2022 proposed budget amendments may be made by majority vote.
- Significant changes to the 2022 proposed budget at the Public Hearing, (the tax levy, appropriations or purpose), would require that the budget summary be re-published.
- After the 2022 Budget Public Hearing process is complete, Section 65.90(5)(a), *Wis. Stats.* requires all changes to the budget to be by a two-thirds vote of the entire City Council membership.

Timeline

- 1. June 23, 2021. 2022 budget overview.
- 2. July 14, 2021. Public Works budget presentation to City Council.
- 3. July 28, 2021. Police and ITS budget presentations to City Council.
- 4. <u>August 11, 2021</u>. Fire/Rescue and Community Development budget presentations to City Council.
- 5. August 25, 2021. 2022 budget presentation and overview.
- 6. <u>August 25, 2021</u>. Library budget presentation to City Council.
- 7. September 15, 2021. Special City Council Meeting
 - Review the 2022 budget
 - Changes are made at this meeting via City Council motions and votes.
 - 2022 Adjusted Budget Summary will be published with the Public Hearing notice.

- Review the proposed 2022-2026 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP)
 - Changes are made at this meeting via City Council motions and votes.
 - Proposed 2022-2026 CIP as adjusted will be posted on City web page.
 - Changes made to 2022 CIP projects need to be reflected in the 2022 Adjusted Budget Summary.
- After this meeting, the budget will not be on the agenda until the Public Hearing.
- 8. <u>October 13 & 20, 2021</u>. Publish Public Hearing Notice and 2022 Proposed Budget Summary. Must be published 15 days in advance of the Public Hearing.
- 9. <u>October 27, 2021</u>. Public Hearings on the 2022 Budget and the 2022 Transit Budget. Public Hearing is not required on the 2022-2026 CIP.
- 10. <u>November 10, 2021</u>.
 - a. Formal adoption of the 2022 City Budget and tax levy.
 - b. Formal adoption of the 2022 Transit Budget.
 - c. Approval of the 2022-2026 Capital Improvement Plan.
- 11. <u>November 19, 2021</u>. The tax billing information will be provided to Fond du Lac County for preparation of the tax bills.
- 12. <u>December 20, 2021</u>. Mail property tax bills by the 3rd Monday in December per WI Statute 74.09(5).
