The City of Fond du Lac Police Department has been notified by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, and Bureau of Justice Assistance that it is eligible for \$12,179 in grant funding for use in late 2024 and 2025.

This funding is distributed to local units of government through the FY2024 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program. This is a "formula" grant; therefore, the amount of funding available to local units of government is determined by the size of the population served and the level of Part 1 violent crime statistics reported via the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS). The purpose of the grant funding is to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime based on local needs and conditions. As this grant is a "formula" grant, there is no match funding requirement for the City of Fond du Lac.

The City of Fond du Lac Police Department would like to apply for this grant and use the funding to purchase a 3D camera system for crime and fire scene documentation.

3D Camera System:

The Department would like to purchase a 3D camera system for the Detective Bureau. This camera system would assist with the preservation of evidence by creating an immersive record which preserves the scene as it was found and provide a non-intrusive method to scan without disturbing physical evidence ensuring the integrity of the scene is maintained. Incorporating a 3D camera system into crime and fire scene investigations enhances documentation, analysis, and communication while preserving evidence and improving efficiency. This tool not only supports the investigative process but also contributes to better prosecution outcomes when applicable and appropriate.

This memo and Exhibit "A" covers agenda item listed as "A" for the Advisory Parking & Traffic Board's September 19, 2024 meeting:

Request to <u>add</u> parking restriction "No Parking Zones" in accordance with Code of Ordinances Section 630-39, Schedule E.

Location: Military Road, South, North Side from a point 175-feet west of the west curbline of South Hickory Street west 60 feet.

City Engineering has initiated this request. The City of Fond du Lac is currently reconstructing S. Military Road from the S Hickory Street intersection to just east of the railroad tracks. The current left turn lane on eastbound S. Military Road to northbound S. Hickory Street is shorter than is normally constructed. The additional parking restrictions along S. Military Road will allow the left turn lane to be constructed to traffic standards.

The Engineering and Traffic Division does support the addition of the parking restrictions along S. Military Road.
