Park Superintendent, John Redmond, presented the Capital Improvement Projects for 2018, including the installation of the Lakeside Park Splash Pad, Taylor Park restroom renovations, Lakeside Park shelter renovations, and Lakeside Park West bathroom renovations and fish cleaning station addition. It was also mentioned that the Lakeside Park Pavilion construction has been pushed to 2020.

**ORDINANCE NO. 3611 (As Amended)****AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 488  
PARKS AND RECREATION, ANIMALS**

**THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Fond du Lac do ordain  
as follows:

**Section 1.** That Chapter 488, Parks and Recreation, Section 488-9.,  
Animals, is hereby amended as follows:

Add Thereto:

D. Dogs in Parks. This Section grants permission for dogs on leashes  
with an adult handler to be in the following parks:

- (1) Colwert-Edward Park
- (2) Harborview Trail from Doty Street to Winnebago Drive
- (3) Hucks Bellevue Park
- (4) Lakeside Park West
- (5) Lallier Park
- (6) Ledgeview Corporate Center
- (7) McDermott Park
- (8) Paul Butzen Park
- (9) Plamore Park
- (10) Russell Park

**Section 2.** Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance  
shall be subject to the penalty provided in Section 1-4 of the Code.


**Section 3.** The appropriate City officials are hereby authorized and  
directed to take such action as is necessary to effectuate the terms of this  
Ordinance.

**Section 4.** All other ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with the  
provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its  
passage and publication as provided by law.





## Chapter 488. Parks and Recreation

### § 488-9. Animals.

- A. No person shall bring any animal into any City park, except in:
- (1) Lakeside Park in an area bounded by Park Avenue, Harbor View Drive, Mohawk Avenue and the boathouses (the exercise area), and in other areas of Lakeside Park to the extent necessary when bringing an animal directly to or from a boat or directly to or from the exercise area.
  - (2) Lakeside Park West in an area designated as a pet exercise area.  
[Added 4-24-2014 by Ord. No. 3544]
  - (3) Conjunction with a permit granted by the City under an applicable provision of this chapter.
- B. Anyone bringing an animal into a permitted area as described in Subsection A shall be responsible for such animal as described in § 216-17 of this Code. This section shall not apply to employees or agents of the City involved in the operation of the parks.
- C. This section shall not apply to a dog specially trained to lead blind or deaf persons or to provide support for mobility-impaired persons.

- D. Dogs in parks. This section grants permission for dogs on leashes with an adult handler to be in the following parks:

- (1) Colwert-Edward Park.
  - (2) Harborview Trail from Doty Street to Winnebago Drive.
  - (3) Hucks Bellevue Park.
  - (4) Lakeside Park West.
  - (5) Lallier Park.
  - (6) Ledgeview Corporate Center.
  - (7) McDermott Park.
  - (8) Paul Butzen Park.
  - (9) Plamore Park.
  - (10) Russell Park.
